TWO JAYS SECRET stalked the pace while racing five wide on the backstretch, rallied before the far turn and was three wide to take command then drew clear in upper stretch and was clearly best. BOUNCE HOUSE was unhurried early then moved up and circled the field while six wide on the far turn making a strong bid then flattened out in the stretch drive. MR B SILVER SECRET was allowed to settle on the run down the backstretch, rallied three wide on the far turn and was gaining ground in the stretch to finish well but was no threat to the top two. DOMINIC'S RED BIRD was seven wide into the first turn then angled in quickly to the rail to saved ground, was in good position on the far turn making a bid then faltered in the stretch. SABINCIELO was unhurried early then made a mild rally while four wide on the far turn and passed tiring rivals in the stretch. MARK OF SUCCESS vied for the lead while three wide, was used up and gave way heading into the far turn. MYSTERIOUS CHARM was allowed to settle on the run down the backstretch while racing four wide, was four wide on the far turn then stopped and was being eased up in late stretch. RICKLES was unhurried early and racing five wide on the backstretch, made a mild bid heading into the far turn then failed to menace in the stretch. K. B. ALEX vied for the lead while four wide, was used up and stopped on the far turn. OCEAN BUN vied for the early lead while inside, was hard used and stopped on the far turn and was being eased up in late stretch. WACO ZONE vied

for the early lead while two wide, was used up and stopped on the far turn and was eased up to a walk in late stretch.
