### Footnotes

AVEC GLASS easily pressed the pace from a position along the rail in the first turn, rated down the backstretch, two wide while still in reserve at the quarter pole, shaken up nearing the eighth pole, responded when showed the whip and won ridden out. PHARME'S PHIRE settled in midpack with a rail trip, still in reserve while two wide in the second turn, urged in the stretch but was outclassed by the winner. MAY ONE was gathered up by the rider coming out of the gate and then unhurried along the rail in the first turn, came under a drive at the quarter pole while five wide, continued to rally down the center of the track. WATERTOWN ROAD eased back and was four wide in the first turn, bumped entering the turn, advanced and was three wide in the second turn and raced evenly in the stretch. AGGIE FRIEND pursued the leader and was three wide in the clubhouse turn, in pursuit of the lead while three wide in the far turn and hung in the stretch. B G NEW IDEA was four wide while pressing the lead group in the first turn then allowed to build a lead with a wide margin down the backstretch, drew off with five furlongs left, was still allowed to run at the three-eighth pole, joined by pursuers at the quarter pole, passed, quickly under the whip while along the rail and soon tired. ALLEY AVENUE was prompted to go to the lead and settled for a two-wide trip in the first turn and was no factor. MISS PEPPER raced along to be in midpack, drifted out to be three wide in the first turn and soon tired. BADNESS was well-rated by the rider while assuming the lead heading into the first turn on the rail, settled back and allowed a rival to draw off down the backstretch before stopping.
