**Footnotes**

COMMON GOLD was allowed to duel for the early lead with a trip along the rail in the opening turn, was well-rated down the backstretch, allowed to run while challenged at the three-eighths pole and was a driving winner. GURU GITA tugged the rider and was three wide pressing the pace in the first turn, stayed on the bit until settling into stride near the half-mile pole, three wide in the second turn but second best. UNEEDA BISCUIT settled in midpack while two wide in the first turn, three wide in the second turn and rallied. FANCY THAT settled behind the lead pair and was two wide in the first turn, soon tugged, three wide second turn, evenly. DANCIN N PRANCIN was allowed to duel for the early lead while two wide in the first turn, challenged for the front spot with three-eighths to go and faltered. SLENDER was content to sit near the back of the pack and was two wide in the first turn and made no rally. SILVER RED BIRD settled in midpack while two wide in the first turn and no factor. FINCHER'S HOPE was restrained to race behind the leaders, under a drive approaching the three-eighths pole, two wide in the second turn and had nothing left. DANCIN INTHE STARS settled behind the lead pair and was three wide in the first turn and stopped. RUNNING TO BOYD unhurried early, was two wide in the clubhouse turn and remained the trailer.
