SOUTHERN CAUSEWAY was content to be near the back early and was on the rail in the opening turn, advanced and was three wide in the second turn through still near the back, after saving ground split through the field, urged at the eighth pole, angled out and was just up in time. STOP TALKING settled near the back and was two wide in the first turn, maintained that position and was two wide in the second turn, shaken up before arriving at the top of the stretch, led but was passed inside the eighth pole, gamely dug in and just missed the win. PALM ROAD reared at the start and stayed at the back on the rail in the first turn, made an advance swung six wide in the second turn and was outfinished. AMMANN RD settled in midpack along the rail in the first turn, was three wide in the second turn but outfinished. J W'S NITRO pressed the pace along the rail in the first turn, was on the rail in the second turn, waited at the quarter pole but had no response when called upon. THUNDER BRITCHES contested the lead and was two wide in the first turn, maintained that position and was two wide in the second turn but faltered late. I AM TARZAN stalked the early lead and was three wide in the clubhouse turn, was three wide in the far turn and tired. GIVEN TRAPP shortly after the start was held up while running right behind AMMANN RD, after being checked raced along in midpack and was two wide in the first turn, raced under restraint at the half-mile pole, was five wide in the second turn and raced evenly in the stretch. ROAD HAWK contested the lead and was two wide in the first turn, maintained that position through the second turn, was used up and had nothing left in the stretch. DOT'S TWO SOCKS was pushed along to contest the lead along the rail through the first turn, kept that position through the second turn and was no threat late.
