Footnotes

CUCOS GONE TO RENO easily went to the lead but soon was challenged, shook loose and had a rail trip in the opening turn, drew clear and continued along the rail in the final turn, was put to a left-handed whip at the top of the stretch and was ridden out in the final sixteenth. PHIL WILL was under a hold to be midpack and had a rail trip in the first turn, continued along the rail in the second turn, angled out at the eighth pole and rallied. SMOKIN MOKEY was under a hold and stalked the leaders then went four wide in the first turn, pulled the rider into contention approaching the three-eighths pole, came under the whip nearing the quarter pole while along the rail and tired late. MORETHANFOREVER near the back early, was on the rail in the first turn, was four wide in the second turn and rallied. FOUR FLAGS was pushed out to be five wide in the opening turn while stalking the frontrunners, advanced and was two wide in the second turn but tired in the stretch. IMPERIAL MARCH was given a nudge to be in midpack and was two wide in the first turn but was no factor. SEND THE HEAT was allowed to contest the lead, veered outward entering the turn and traveled three wide through it, fought the rider through the turn and into the backstretch and soon tired. FLY BY TRAFFIC was slow at the start and was given a shake of the reins, trailed and was two wide in the opening turn and showed little. THEATRICAL JOE was allowed to contest the lead but was pushed four wide in the clubhouse turn, steadied while three wide at the quarter pole and stopped.
