HAPPY TOO STAR was under a hold while tracking the leaders along the rail in the first turn, moved out to be three wide while moving on the leaders at the quarter pole and was a driving winner. FIVE AFLEET settled back and was two wide in the first turn, swung out four wide in the second turn to challenge the lead and rallied. TATNALL STREET while near the back of the pack swung out to be two wide in the first turn, was five wide in the second turn and rallied. COUNCIL OAK pressed the pace alongside the frontrunner, was two wide in the first turn, dueled for the lead down the backstretch, was two wide in the second turn and tired in the final sixteenth. ONLY MAN IN TOWN was prompted to the front and secured a rail trip, was challenged down the backstretch, kept along the rail but tired in the stretch. BEAN pulled the rider while saving ground through the opening turn and lacked a response. PORT OF SEATTLE was near the back and three wide in the first turn, was slow to advance and six wide in the second turn and made no bid. SWINGIN CAT settled off the pace and was three wide in the first turn, retreated. FIEND A BIT trailed the first time in front of the grandstand, three wide in the first turn and continued to trail.
