Weight: 123 lbs. The field will be limited to (14) fourteen horses. Highest career earnings at time of entry will be preferred.

Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Horses not drawing a starting position in the gate will receive a refund of the entry fee. A suitable award will be presented to the winning owner.

SAND ON FIRE was pushed along early by the rider to gain a spot in midpack, continued a slow advance and was two wide in the turn, drifted out with the lead at the eighth pole and held on. TTT TINY TINA was sent up to challenge the lead, had a rail trip while still on the lead in the turn, gave way at the eighth pole and was outfinished. ZELLS FOLLIES easily pressed the pace, got caught four wide in the turn, loomed a threat at the eighth pole but hung in that position to the wire. TIKIS SANDY VAZ went to the early lead, was pushed along while two wide at the quarter pole, did not respond and tired through the stretch. RV ROULETTE in a prominent spot early, was taken up at the five-eighths pole, sent down to the rail by the rider and again put under restraint at the seven-sixteenth marker, came under the whip at the five-sixteenth marker, was three wide in the turn and failed to rally. WMA BURNING FIRE was urged along to keep pace with the frontrunners early, dropped back and was three wide in the turn and no factor. WMA GODSPEED broke slowly and was pushed along but still at the back of the pack, failed to advance and was two wide in the turn and remained far back.
