WAKI MISWAKI pressed pace four wide in the opening turn, stalked down the backstretch, was two wide in the final turn, urged at the eighth pole but given a hand ride soon after to the wire. MAMBO COUNCIL secured a prominent position among the lead group and was two wide in the first turn, was three wide in the second turn, shaken up at the top of the stretch but no match for the winner. ALFAJOR was unhurried and seven wide in the clubhouse turn, dropped in to the inside, was on the move while angling out four wide on the far turn, managed a rally through the stretch but could not get past the second-place finisher. PEAKABOO BRIDE settled in midpack and was four wide in the first turn, was slow to advance and got caught five wide in the second turn and raced evenly in the stretch. DAVIDSON CREEK settled but was swung out six wide in the first turn, was two wide in the second turn, mild bid. WITT'S CHROME was allowed to settle in midpack and was three wide in the first turn, was two wide in the second turn yet proved no factor late. ESPECTACOLAR QUEST was ridden along midpack and two wide in the first turn, three wide in the second turn and failed to advance. ON A BLACK CHARGER pressed the pace three wide in the first turn, four wide in the second turn and faltered. ALL RED hustled to the lead and the rail for the first turn, maintained that position through the second turn but tired. KOKOMO BAY veered out at the start and remained wide until entering the first turn 12-wide, dropped down to find the rail in time for the second turn but had no chance to make an impact. RUFF SLEW was allowed to settle with a rail trip in the first turn and soon tired.
