Footnotes

ESSCALATOR easily went to the early lead, widened at the seven-sixteenths marker without being asked, had a rail trip, was shaken up nearing the eighth pole and given a few taps with the whip, responded and won while being ridden out. TASTEFULLYXCESSIVE easily pursued the early leader, put under a drive at the three-eighths pole, was two wide in the turn, kept busy under a left-handed whip in the stretch but no match for the winner. PLATINUM SONG bumped a tad at the start, ridden along but was near the back of the pack, lacked room at the seven-sixteenths marker, circled through the turn while four wide before racing evenly in the stretch. MY GOLDEN BELLE bumped a tad at the start, ridden along to reach midpack, was three wide in the turn and made no rally late. FALLING STAR stalked the leader, had a rail trip while pursuing the leader at the quarter pole and faltered. WITT'S EXPECTATION was ridden along in midpack, lost ground approaching the five-sixteenths marker and was done.
