B G WANT ME BACK settled in midpack, angled out approaching the quarter pole and was five wide, continued the rally along the outside of the field in the stretch and was a driving winner. R MEMORIES pressed the pace, was two wide in the turn, gamely split horses past the eighth pole and dug in for second. PRINCESS GAGA chased the leaders, traveled along the rail in the turn yet hung in that position in deep stretch. JOSEPH COUNTDOWN was shaken up to get the early lead, two paths off the rail while on the lead through the turn, was used up and tired close to the wire. NAVASOTA ROSE settled toward the back, was three wide in the turn and found room by angling out at the top of the stretch, continued on between horses in the stretch with a mild bid but did not have enough left. BONNIE'S CROWN was prompted coming out of the starting gate, three wide while contesting the lead in the turn, raced evenly in the stretch. LUV DUMP pursued the lead, was four wide in the turn and faltered. SUGAR PRINCESS stalked the early lead, was four wide in the turn and retreated. IF DIRTWEREDOLLAR settled toward midpack but soon trailed.
