Footnotes

SPANISH FEVER ridden along mildly near the back, circled six wide at the quarter pole and rallied through the center of the lane. DENALI MIST pushed along hard to duel for the lead, had a rail trip, led with a sixteenth of a mile to go but was outfinished. IMPERIAL POMEROY was bumped and shuffled back at the start, angled out six wide at the quarter pole yet made a determined rally through the stretch. OPTIONAL was allowed to duel for the early lead, was two wide in the turn but faltered in deep stretch. FLYER'S FANTASY steadied at the nine-sixteenths marker, was slow to advance and was two wide in the turn and made a late rally. BRAZZLE DAZZLE was put under pressure with the whip early and hard ridden to chase the leaders, five wide in the turn and did not threaten. SHE IS A OLMOS ridden along to pursue the lead, three wide in the turn, retreated. BULINDAMARIE allowed to press the pace, lacked room while four wide at the quarter pole and stopped.
