PHARME'S MISSTEAK was ridden along at the back, advanced and was four wide at the quarter pole, angled in to be three wide at the top of the stretch, split horses at the eighth pole, got a couple of cracks with the whip and won while ridden out in the final sixteenth. YULE YARNS GIRL mildly ridden along to the lead, traveled along the rail, was under constant urging in the stretch yet gave way. SWEET CONSOLIDATOR broke sharply and was ridden along to contest the lead, four wide in the turn and slowly gained with a rally in the stretch. P K'S PHILLY was slow to start, shaken up and promptly advanced to reach midpack, continued under a hard drive nearing the five-sixteenth marker while two wide, drifted out in the stretch while still under that long drive and made no impact in the stretch. RACHEL'S SPECIAL settled toward the back, three wide in the turn and made a slight advance. I KNOW JOE pressed the pace, three wide in the turn, used up and faltered in the stretch. MUCHO MARY was urged along and chased the lead, caught five wide in the turn and failed to advance. MAGICAL APPEAL settled toward the back, five wide in the turn and was no menace. MIRACLE ON HIGH ridden along to pursue the lead, was two wide in the turn, tired in the stretch. WHY'S THAT settled off the leader, was two wide under a drive in turn and checked in the final sixteenth.
