Footnotes

DEPUTY WHY was allowed to settle in midpack and was five wide in the first turn, three wide while on the move in the far turn, angled out further outside and prevailed getting up after a drive at the wire. DEAD CAT BOUNCE was kept in midpack under restraint and two wide in the first turn, was four wide in the second turn and was edged at the wire. COUNTDOWN SHOWDOWN settled in midpack and was three wide in the first turn, waited for room at the seven-sixteenth marker, came in tight quarters along the rail again five-sixteenths from the wire, moved out to be three wide at the quarter pole, led in the final sixteenth but was outfinished. ABBY BOY stalked the lead two wide in the first turn, made it to the rail for the second turn and hung in the stretch. MIDTOWN GROOM was ridden along to pursue the early lead and was three wide in the first turn and finished evenly in the stretch. DOITFORJOHNNY settled in midpack and had the rail in the first turn and made a mild bid late. LUCKY INDIAN reared at the start and was off balance and did not seriously threaten. ROYAL CAUSEWAY went to an easy early lead and secured a spot on the rail in the first turn, maintained that position through the second turn but tired in the stretch. MATAMBRE was mildly ridden along to be four wide in the first turn while pursuing the lead but failed to mount a bid. CROOK'S G MONEY unhurried at the start and five wide in the first turn and failed to reach contention. KOOL SOLDIER squeezed back at the start and was always near

the back. APALACHE KING was ridden along to press the pace and was two wide in the first turn, was asked for more at the five-furlongs grounds but stopped.
