TRACK THE RUMOR was unhurried, rallied three wide around the final turn, vied into the stretch then prevailed after a stiff drive. LADY SCHWARTZMAN was slow to settle, swung wide into the stretch and gained steadily to the end. G' MORNIN DONNA rallied two wide into contention nearing the stretch but wasn't enough after a tough drive. WILD AND WACKY was bumped soundly at the break, swung wide into the stretch, angled in between rivals and finished willingly. HITCHED was no factor. RITZ OF NATAL moved up inside but lacked a strong late closing. RUNAWAY RUNNER moved up into tight quarters along the rail nearing the far turn then was taken up in tight in early stretch. DIFFICULT DOLL sped to a long early lead and stopped. ETALON OR was finished early and was eased up. WATCH PHILOMENA showed little and was eased up.
