CLASSICAL MONEY stalked the pace two wide, steadily closed outside leaving the far turn and edged clear under strong handling. COIN RETURN close up throughout and three wide into the first turn, finished willingly but couldn't get passed the winner. PAWN BRAT pressed the pace two wide, gained command and the rail entering the final turn then weakened. MR. PISTOLS never far back, rail first turn, came three wide, needed more. PROSPECT'S PRIZE unhurried inside, no threat, passed tired rivals. HUNTS LANDING chased three wide early, in contention to far turn, weakened. CHANCE FOR BERT never too far back, mild bid far turn, tired. THUNDERING STORM settled near rail, mild bid inside far turn, tired. GLITGO hustled to front, gained inside, tired. JACK'S GOLD unhurried four wide early, wide leaving far turn, tired. NASRUDIN brief speed, three wide early, tired.
