Footnotes

NOSKI was caught in tight quarters along the rail around the first turn, came out between rivals entering the stretch, angled in and reached the front in late stretch. VALID MISS CHAIN moved to press two wide, opened a short lead in early stretch but couldn't contain the winner. SAPHIENT lagged early, rallied wide around the final turn, continued between rivals through the stretch then bore out under left hand whip and bumped LT'L MANDY A and gained the show. TIME CAP steadied while trying to bear out between rivals on the first turn, was in tight into the far turn and lacked a strong closing response. LT'L MANDY A was unhurried early, rallied wide around the final turn then gained slowly and was bumped through the final sixteenth. G' MORNIN DONNA made the early pace inside then weakened in the lane. MISS SARAJEVO was no factor. TRACK THE RUMOR lacked room along the rail into the far turn then flattened out. LOVERS FIRE was finished early. I PREFER ASHLEY showed speed three wide to the far turn and stopped.
