Footnotes

TRICKY PRINCE was rated out from the rail within easy striking distance, moved to vie around the final turn, drew clear entering the stretch and was kept to urging. LIKEABLE IRISH was shut off leaving the gate, made a run three wide into the far turn to vie then flattened out in the stretch. THE KAISER made a mild run along the rail around the final turn and continued evenly through the stretch. KRABBIE was caught in tight along the rail around the first turn, came out wide nearing the stretch and hung. STARSHIP SEMINOLE (VEN) made the pace inside to the stretch and tired. OAK SPRINGS ACE showed early speed then stopped. DIAMOND RANSOM was outrun. TOURIST TRAP showed some speed inside then stopped and was eased up.
