Footnotes

RUNAWAY RUNNER was confidently rated three wide within easy striking distance, moved to the front early on the far turn and held sway under mild urging. NAUGHTY LINDA rallied the three path into the far turn, angled in entering the stretch and hung. PROFESSIONAL LADY stalked two wide early, took over entering the backstretch then tired through the final quarter. LA BLONDA (ARG) rallied into tight quarters between rivals on the far turn then flattened out. DUBIOUS (GB) was very slow at the break, moved up three wide between rivals into the far turn then flattened out. HAVEN'S THIRD ROSE was no factor. MYDAWTERTHELAWYER was in tight between rivals on the backstretch then stopped. GAY AND BOLD was always far back and was eased up through the stretch. BUTTONWOOD BAYSTAR made the early pace inside, stopped and was eased up through the stretch.
