Footnotes

NOSKI steadied in tight along the rail on the first turn, moved through tight quarters along the rail into the far turn, stayed along the rail into the stretch and drew out through the final sixteenth under brisk urging. REPRIZED DREAM dueled inside from the outset, drifted a bit entering the stretch and couldn't stay with the winner. VALID MISS CHAIN dueled two wide from the outset and weakened in the lane. NANA'S TOY wasn't far back inside, came out three wide on the final turn for room while rallying then flattened out in the stretch. RIVIERA COLLEEN was steadied in tight between rivals into the first turn, rallied four wide into the far turn to vie then tired. PRIVATE ESTATE was no factor. SIDE SADDLE (IRE) showed speed three wide and stopped. LAST BOAT EAST showed speed between rivals, steadied into the far turn and stopped.
