Footnotes

BLUE HILL AVE attended the pace two wide throughout, battled gamely into upper stretch, drifted inward under right hand pressure when nearing the chute then prevailed in the final yards. PAWN BRAT set the pace from the rail, was carried into the chute by the winner while continuing to battle gamely and was outfinished in the final forty yards.. PRIZED MAX was well reserved along the inside around the first turn, was always in contention but lacked a strong late bid. THUNDERING STORM was never too far back while two wide throughout then weakened. WHO LUVS YOU BABY chased three wide early, was a factor to the top of the stretch and weakened. FLEET MAN stalked the leaders to the far turn, loomed three wide leaving that turn and weakened thereafter. MOON BOW was five wide entering the first turn, chased four wide around the far turn and tired. ROMPE BOLAS, four wide into the first turn, chased for half-mile and tired. TALC OF DREAMS was off a step slow then was outrun while well off rail turns. After a Stewards' inquiry into the stretch run and an objection by the rider of PAWN BRAT for alleged interference in the stretch, BLUE HILL AVE was disqualified and placed second.
