CHEROKEE TUNE quickly gained the early advantage from the inside, opened a clear advantage entering the stretch and was under mild urging late. SABORCAT pressed the pace outside, remained close through the stretch but could not keep pace while second best. HI PRO GAL pressed the pace inside but weakened late. HONEY STAR stalked the pace between foes, made a bid entering the stretch but was too late. HOPES ENGLISH had an even trip while no factor. TAKE THE FLAG was finished early. SPLIT DIVIDEND raced near the back throughout. STARRY MESSENGER was never close and eased at the finish.
