ALL ABOUT US raced three wide. GOOD OFFER pressed pace, through after half. CLOSE COPY steadied briefly after first furlong. AN EVEN MARK shuffled back and bumped start. ENSIGN JAKE pushed into rival at start. HE WILL rail trip, no factor. JUSTINTIME G dull effort.
