DANDIONE up close inside, inched closer entering the turn, remained inside for the drive, responded to pressure and outfinished rivals the final yards. KENTUCKY RUCKUS away in good order, dueled from the inside for the early lead, gained a clear advantage at the eighth pole but was outfinished. ELISHA JOY well placed outside early, reached a striking position entering the stretch, responded but was too late. CRAFTY G went evenly. DANS RAMBLER was no factor. PERFECTLY CATTY dueled from the outside and tired. PICTURE THIS TUX was always outrun.
