MCKIMS BID unhurried inside early, steadily advanced up the backstretch, made a bid entering the stretch and was gaining late. SALTY TAM outrun early, altered course outside entering the second turn, responded to pressure and was gaining late. ELEKTRONA had an even trip. B. B. GUN never threatened. O' DOLLY dueled from the outside early but tired. SANDRA DI dueled from between rivals but faded.
