JOHNNY WHIP within striking distance just off leaders from start, came three wide into stretch, gained command mid stretch, responded to mild urging, drew clear late. STAGHORN vied for lead from outset, altered course mild stretch, responded to handling and got up for second spot. LIL R'SLAST was never far back along inside, lacked rally in drive. BROWN OKIE came from middle of pack five wide into stretch, failed to menace. LUCKY RADAR was allowed to settle early, passed tiring foes along rail in lane. SLEW LUNA failed to menace. STAR'S VALENTINO vied on the outside of rivals to stretch, gave way. GUNSMOKE N hustled to front along rail before half, faded. MY DEBIT CARD hustled to front from break, dropped back before half mile. PARADISE CITY was always outrun.
