NORTHERN SUMMER stalked the pace between rivals, made a bid entering the turn, responded to pressure and drew clear the final furlong. EVASIVE PROSPECT dueled from the outside but could not keep pace while clearly second best. DARLIN DIXIE dueled from just off the rail but weakened the final furlong. TA TA MORO never far back while outside, made a bid entering the stretch but too late. FASTYBUTNASTY could only improve position. PALM SUNDAY forwardly placed early, lacked a late bid. BAY RUM BEAUTY dueled from between rivals but tired. ESLAHORA forwardly placed inside, tired. YOU CAN COUNTMEIN showed little. MISS TIME ART was always outrun.
