MUST BE HE dueled from the outside for the early lead, dueled up the backstretch, dueled through the second turn, gained a clear advantage at the eighth pole and was well clear late while kept to task. ENSIGN JAKE chased the early pace outside, inched closer up the backstretch, dueled through the second turn but could not keep pace late. EXCLUSIVE RIO forced the early pace inside, remained a froward factor entering the stretch but was no match late. CODY'S COLONY unhurried early while outside, advanced entering the second turn but could only improve position. MONEY POWER could only pass tired ones. MATT'S GHOST was no factor. BURBANK BOOGIE chased the pace outside and tired. SKY RISEN had a steady fade. CHOCOLATE MISS was finished early. LOST PET was outrun.
