FINAL FOUR GIRL stalked the early pace outside, made a bid entering the turn but could not reach the winner. SUELLEN up close from between foes, made a bid entering the turn but could not sustain the effort. SLEEK FLYER well placed from between foes, had a mild late gain. CHRISTINA'S ANGEL could only pass tired ones. NOVA SCOTIA NORMA dueled from the inside and tired. DIVA BRIDE was no factor. GOOD MEDICINE chased the pace and tired. MISS TUFFET was no threat. SASSY SYLVIA was finished. CATHOUSE SAINT had little interest. PARKLANE BITE OVER showed little.
