Footnotes

BRECKENRIDGE came from off the pace five wide into stretch when making bid, responded to gain command mid stretch, kept to steady urging while mid track and drew clear late. SPARK PLUG was allowed to settle early, came six wide into stretch, rallied and finished full of run while mid track. DAAREB well back at the half while racing along inside, finished with a solid belated rail rally. BLUE MEMO hustled to front, set pace into stretch, went gamely to mid stretch, gave way. BALDACCI well back at the half, raced five wide into stretch, finished with a mild mid track bid. VALLEY FOG was never far back on the

outside, five wide into lane, moved up to loom danger mid stretch, flattened out. WILLOWY DANSEUR stalked leaders into stretch, gave way. STRAIGHT FLASH raced along inside, never a factor. EPIC MATCH saved ground while forwardly positioned into stretch, gave way. TIZTIME forwardly positioned along inside for half, faded. VALID SPECTACLE was never a threat. CUSTOM JET dueled on the outside of foe for half, faded steadily thereafter. STORM IN THE LAKE forwardly positioned outside rivals for quarter mile, dropped back. MIDWAY TAP was always outrun.
