LEAVE A LEGACY outrun early, bid entering the stretch while inside, altered out for the drive and wore down BAYTOWN late. The latter, sent to the early lead, increased his advantage up the backstretch, remained the leader entering the stretch but could not last. CHIEF THREE SOX forced the issue inside but weakened in the drive. TOLL BOOTH WILLIE unhurried early, rallied outside too late while drifting in late. DYNABOY raced forwardly inside but lacked the needed late bid. SIR TIFF pressed the pace between rivals and tired. RARE MONEY close up outside, faded. This race was hand timed.
