CUVEE STAR within striking distance on the outside from outset, came four wide into lane, responded to urging, gain advantage mid stretch, remained clear to wire. SUPREME SECRET forwardly positioned along inside into stretch, lacked the needed late kick in drive. TAMQEEN rallied five wide from middle of pack, finished with a solid belated mid track rally. EARLY FINAL chased pace for mid stretch, tired. KING GULCH well back at the half, finished with a solid belated mid track rally. COSTA DE ORO failed to menace. BATESVILLE hustled to front, gave way after half. MAJESTIC STAG never threatened. BREWSKI SLEW was outrun.
