KIMBELL'S BLING well positioned outside rivals from start, came five wide into stretch when making bid, took command mid stretch, kept to mild urging and drew off. LOVE CHARBIE was never far back, moved up along rail leaving far turn, responded in lane but no match for winner and settle for second best. TRAILFINDER well positioned into stretch, tired in drive, pulled up in distress after the running, vanned off. KIRSTIE was allowed to settle early, came four wide into stretch, lacked response when asked in drive. HARRIMANS MAE LADY failed to menace. BANDS PLAYING stalked leaders into stretch, gave way. QUEEN KYLEE was not a factor. HEARTLAND XPRESS hustle4d to front, set pace for half, dropped back. MOKALATA dueled while between foes for half, faded. BARBRAWL was outrun.
