UH OH BANGO was never far back, came three wide into lane when making bid into lane, moved nearest leader mid stretch, no match for winner but clearly second best. WESTERN FORUM allowed to settle early, commenced four wide into stretch, finished with a belated mid track rally. BIG TEXAS DADDY well back for half, came five wide when making bid into lane, had no late response. RANGE WAR failed to menace. COSMO GIRL hustled to front, gave way after half. MAN CHESTER MAN was not a factor. LONE STAR COWBOY chased leaders for half, gave way. TRUCKIN was outrun.
