STAKES Red Earth S. Black Type - Thoroughbred

FOR THREE-YEAR-OLDS AND UPWARD. ACCREDITED OKLAHOMA FOALS. No nomination fee. \$250 to pass the entry box.

Starters to pay \$500 additional with \$30,000 guaranteed by Remington Park and an additional \$20,000 included from the Oklahoma Bred Fund. The guaranteed money and OBF funds to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Three Year Olds, 118 lbs. Older, 123 lbs. Non-winners of \$18,000 twice in 2013 allowed 2 lbs., \$18,000 once in 2013, 4 lbs., \$9,000 in 2013, 6 lbs. Maiden and claiming races not considered in weight allowances. Starters to be named through the entry box at the usual time of entry. This race will be limited to 12 starters. (High Weights Preferred, Then Highest Lifetime Earnings Will Be Used In Determining The Order Of Preference Of Horses Assigned Equal Weights On The Scale). A suitable award will be presented to the winning owner. Closed August 14th with (38) nominations. (If management deems it necessary to take this race off the Turf, it will be run at a distance of 1 Mile on the main track.). (S)

SOONER SUPERSTAR within striking distance along inside from outset, moved boldly along rail during stretch drive, got up in final strides. POLKA JOKE dueled on the outside of rivals from start, gained clear advantage at the half, went gamely under pressure in drive only to be outnodded in the end. PACAR was allowed to settle in drive for the first half, swung five wide when making bid into stretch, responded to handling and finished well but too late. IMAHIT well back for half, moved forwardly outside rivals leaving far turn, came five wide into stretch, finished with a solid mid track bid. STRATEGIC LEADER well back along inside for half, responded to handling in drive and finished with a solid late rail rally. IN THE BAND hustled to clear early lead, dueled into stretch, went gamely before gave way mid stretch. Z ROCKSTAR stalked leaders along rail into stretch, went gamely in drive before giving way in late going. TED'S FOLLY well back from outset, lacked response when asked. OKIETATE wide from outset, never a factor. CAPTURE THE FLAG forwardly positioned along inside from outset, came off rail four wide into stretch, faded. OAKIE FLASH was outrun. JOHNNY WHIP vied with early leaders, dropped back after quarter

mile.
