SWEET BABY LONDON within striking distance outside from outset, came three wide into lane, willingly gained nod mid stretch, unchallenged ridden out to wire. DIXIE DUSK came from middle of pack along inside into stretch, responded to steady urging in drive and got up for the second spot. KATIE'S COUSIN well back at the half along inside, three wide into lane, finished with a belated mid track rally. PRINCESS RHAYE was never far back outside rivals from start, moved up to loom danger mid stretch, flattened out. MEGA WAVE trailed at the half, passed tiring foes. PERFECT LASSIE was not far back along inside for half, swung five wide into stretch, came up empty in drive. WEE PROSPECT hustled to front, set pace for half, faded steadily thereafter. SUGAR GHOST was never a threat. PAPA'S BOO BEAR chased pace for half, stopped.
