THE JUDGE SEZ WHO unhurried early, steadily advanced up the backstretch, altered outside entering the second turn, responded when asked, dueled through the stretch with A.P. FIVE HUNDRED and EASYFROMTHEGITGO and outfinished those two after a stretch long duel. EASYFROMTHEGITGO allowed to settle early, inched closer up the backstretch, remained inside entering the stretch, responded to pressure to duel with the winner through the stretch only to be outfinished in a game effort. A. P. FIVE HUNDRED dueled from the outside for the early lead, dueled through the stretch with the winner but was outfinished in a game try. PREMEDITATION well placed outside early, inched closer entering the stretch to make a bid but faltered late. MISSME chased the early pace inside but had nothing left for the drive. COWBOY STUFF broke sharp from between foes to set the early pace but weakened when the real test came. GREY BEARD showed little. DUSTY SPIKE was never close. WISHINGITWAS chased the early pace inside but gave way.
