CHOCTAW BINGO was away alertly, and set a pressured pace, led throughout and never pressured, drew off at the top of the lane to be much the best. SENECA ROYALTY chased the leader, raced inside while dueling with rivals, winner to tuff. VIC'S THE MAN raced three wide behind leader while headed by rivals, offered a mild bid but could not close gap as winner drew off. PAPERDONTSAYTHAT off slowly, was allowed to settle, offered a late rally but failed to menace. HORSE FEVER dueled three quarters behind leader, weakened. LITTLE WAGON bobbled after start, failed to respond. GRAND CHANT never a factor. KING HIGH STRAIGHT trailed, showed little, and was distanced.
