SERENA VENUS stalked leaders throughout, had no rally. HOT SUMMER SQUALL forwardly positioned for half, failed to menace. SUBLIMATION was never a factor. MIZZ INDY CAT trailed for quarter mile, improved position. CORRESPONDENCE was never a threat. JOE'S HALO was always outrun. SOX ON A FOX was never close. FRIENDLY SUMMER forwardly positioned while wide of rivals for half, dropped back. SULTRY GAL showed little, bled, eased, crossed finish.
