**Footnotes**

YES IT'S HOT within striking distance outside rivals from outset, responded into lane, engaged leader mid stretch, drifted outward during late going, impeded rival, got up in time. DOCTOR D'S QUEST well back early while along inside, rallied along rail into lane, finished strong and just missed getting to winner. DIMMIT was never far back, came five wide into stretch, responded to steady urging during while being forced outward during late going and just missed in a game effort. TRULY INSPIRED broke to front, set pace with a narrow lead into stretch, went gamely before weakening in late going. JONES BOOTS forwardly positioned along inside into stretch, lacked needed response in drive. BOLD TOCCET wide while in back early, finished with a mild belated bid. HOMEISAHONKEYTONK raced in middle of pack, had no rally. VALID THIEF was not a factor. FOOLISH BILL chased early pace, faded. RIVER CITY DREAM was outrun. EL COLE was never close.
