SHOTGUN GULCH was never far back racing along rail, benefited when rivals fanned out into stretch, took over mid stretch, responded to mild urging, remained clear to wire. KISS ME CHOCOLATE hustled to front, drifted outward three wide into stretch, no match for winner in drive but clearly best of others. VERTICAL VISION stalked leaders from outset, forced four wide into stretch, moved up to loom danger mid stretch, flattened out. STRAWBERRY CHASE raced along inside, lacked response. REEL CHROME chased pace for half, gave way. GOING OKIE was never a threat.
