FOR THREE-YEAR-OLDS AND UPWARD. ACCREDITED OKLAHOMA FOALS. No nomination fee. \$250 to pass the entry box. Starters to pay \$250 additional with \$30,000 guaranteed by Remington Park and an additional \$20,000 included from the Oklahoma Bred Fund. The guaranteed money and OBF funds to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weights: Three Year Olds 118 lbs. Older 124 lbs. Non-winners of \$18,000 twice in 2010 allowed 2 lbs., \$18,000 once in 2010, 4 lbs., \$9,000 in 2010, 6 lbs. Maiden and claiming races not considered in weight allowances. Starters to be named through the entry box at the usual time of entry. This race will be limited to 12 starters. (High Weights Preferred According To The Scale, Then Highest Lifetime Earnings Will Be Used In Determining The Order Of Preference Of Horses Assigned Equal Weights). Closed Thursday, August 19th with (34) nominations. A suitable award will be presented to the winning owner. (If management deems it necessary to take this race off the Turf, it will be run at a distance of 1 Mile on the main track.). (S)

EVENING REWARD within striking distance while racing between rivals from outset, responded to steady urging during stretch drive, got up in final strides. SKEDEE stalked leaders from outset, came three wide into stretch, gained narrow edge mid stretch, went gamely to wire only to be outnodded on the wire. TI TOWNSHIP well back leaving far turn, swung six wide into stretch, finished with a belated stretch rally. MOTION APPROVED well back while saving ground for half, rallied between rivals into stretch, loomed danger mid stretch, weakened. STRATEGIC LEADER well back leaving far turn, circled eight wide into stretch, finished with a belated mid track rally. SOME QUICK raced in middle of pack into stretch, had no rally. JUMP TO THE CHASE trailed for the first half, not a factor. MUST BE HE raced in middle of pack for half, gave way. TIZARKO hustled to front, dueled for half, faded thereafter. OKIE TIME was never a threat. TWO TIMIN SLEW stalked pace on the outside of rivals for half, faded steadily thereafter.
