DETENTION set pace along rail for half, lost advantage into stretch, responded to steady urging in drive to wire and proved best in a game effort. TEXAS BLING was never far back outside rivals, finished well with a strong mid track bid that just missed. SMOKEY DEPUTY dueled on the outside of pace from outset, responded to gain advantage into stretch, weakened in late going. REAL APPEAL DEAL moved up from mid pack to loom danger into stretch, flattened out. JERRY N DUKE saved ground while forwardly positioned into stretch to no avail. MY TIP well back at the half, lacked response when asked. TWO GUNS raced along inside in back, failed to menace. KIPPER DAN was never a factor. FIRE YOUR BOSS was never a serious threat. RULE BREAKER was outrun. BOB FUDGE forwardly positioned for half, faded. FLASHY REBEL was never close.
