LEAVE A LEGACY, allowed to settle, made a steady advance outside, bid on the second turn and found his best stride too late. SIR TIFF, set the early pace, drew clear and weakened in late stretch. MR ROSS made a steady advance outside, bid on the second turn and came up empty. ACCELERATED TIME, bumped at the start, stalked the pace inside and made a steady retreat. HEART SURGEON, broke in at the start, lacked speed and was no threat. THEWAYTOGO, broke in at the start, stalked the pace outside and weakened. RARE MONEY, never far back off the rail was through after a half.
