MOMMA'S BADNEWS stalked leaders on the outside from start, came three wide into lane, responded to steady urging, got up in time. JUKEBOX JUNKIE duled on the outside of foe from outset, gained narrow edge into lane, went gamely under pressure but couldn't last. TANALIAN trailed for half, moved up along rail, finished with a burst of energy to gain show spot and was gaining on the top pair. READY TO SMOKEM within striking distance along inside throughout, lacked late kick. KINETIC MOTION hustled to front, set pace to top stretch, gave way in lane. BEGG'S raced along inside, failed to menace. BATESVILLE was not a factor. TUFF RUFF ANDREADY never threatened. BRECKENRIDGE forwardly positioned outside rivals to stretch, faded. MAHA RAHY vied for early lead while between foes, dropped back in lane.
