DOLCE VITA, broke awkwardly, made a steady advance outside, bid on the second turn, rallied and drew clear late. XENA, allowed to settle, made a steady advance, bid on the second turn and closed late. LET THE MYSTERY BE, saved ground, angled out on the second turn and made a mild late rally. VERT 'N' MERT, stalked the pace, rallied between horses and failed to sustain her bid. SHOE SHINE BABY, vied for the early lead, dueled, bid along the rail on the second turn and weakened in upper stretch. CEDAR LAKE MS, vied for the lead inside, dueled and was through early. HI PLAINS COUNTESS, saved ground, dropped back and was outrun.
