DELWOOD rated off early pace, commenced bid leaving far turn, came three wide into stretch, responded to strong handling while racing mid track, got up in final strides. COOL'S PHIRE chased leader into stretch, responded to gain nod mid stretch, went gamely under pressure to wire only to be outriddled in the end. T. C. CHAMP broke to front along rail, set pace into stretch, went gamely to mid stretch, tired in late going. SHEKINAH trailed at the half, six wide improved position in lane. SHOE SHOE SHOE well back into stretch, failed to menace. PERSHING was never a factor. MAKE THE GRADE stalked leaders into stretch, faded. FR. DENIS saved ground while being outrun.
