**Footnotes**

PURSUE A DREAM within striking distance along inside from outset, responded to steady urging to gain nod mid stretch, kept to task to wire and prevailed in a game effort. BRASS BAND allowed to settle early, worked way forwardly during run down backstretch along inside, swung to mid track entering stretch, responded well, just missed. RED BIRDS MAGICIAN was never far back on the outside of rivals, raced five wide into stretch, finished well and getting to top pair in final stages. HIGH MEISTER in middle of pack along rail, found room along inside entering stretch, finished with a solid belated bid. CATTLE BARON hustled to front, set pace for half along inside, tired in drive. CHARLIE'S REPRIZED well back along inside early, moved up along inside during run down backstretch, swung to middle of lane in drive and finished with a mild mid track rally. MARK HIS WORD forwardly positioned on the outside of rivals to stretch, gave way. SUNDAY SAMURAI forwardly positioned for half, failed to menace in drive. LONGER THAN UNO raced on the outside of rivals and not a factor. COMPULSION was never a threat. MOLLY'S DANCER chased pace for half, faded. HARRIS FORTUNE was always outrun.
