SNOW RISK was allowed to settle along inside early, came five wide into lane, forced to alter course when lacking room mid stretch, responded when clear and drew off in late going. FOREVER SLEW was never far back, commenced bid racing five wide into stretch, gained nod mid stretch, flattened out. F C TONIGHT I RIDE was allowed to settle early, came four wide into lane, finished with a mild rally. Q P SLEW stalked leaders into stretch, moved up to loom danger mid stretch, gave way. LIGHTNINGONACHAIN dueled on the outside of rivals for half, gave way. HE'SINDYSTRUCTIBLE came five wide from mid pack into stretch, failed to menace. PLAIN PICKENS stalked leaders along rail into stretch, dropped back. FRED HENRY hustled to front, set pace for half, faded. JOHNNY BLACKFOOT was always outrun.
