SHARP WAGER was never far back, came willingly five wide into stretch, took command mid stretch, unchallenged, ridden out to wire. DIXIE GROOM well back after a half, circled six wide into stretch, finished with a solid rally to gain second spot. SUGARINTHEEVENING broke to front, set pace for half, tired in lane. LEE'S SOUTH chased pace for half, gave way. MASTER TIME was never a threat. BLACK IDA'S JO JO vied for lead to half mile marker, faded steadily thereafter.
