ON THE LOOSE AGAIN was allowed to settle early, commenced bid circling rivals leaving far turn, took over into stretch, kept to task in drive while increasing margin. DUSTY OKIE broke to front, set pace into stretch, no match for winner in drive but well clear of others. FLYER'S SPIRIT stalked leaders for half, gave way. BRIAN G forwardly positioned for half, came four wide into lane, faded in drive. HIGH CARD chased pace for three quarters, dropped back. LUCKY DOOBEH was always outrun. ROAD RAGE G was never close.
